

ARROW WARRANTY

Congratulations on the purchase of your new JUDY sewing cabinet. Every effort has been taken to ensure your complete satisfaction with this custom designed product. For your convenience, the ready-to-assemble JUDY cabinet is provided in two boxes.

Helpful Assembly Hints

Read the instructions carefully before starting. Please open and inspect the contents of both boxes to see that all parts are included. You will need a Phillips head and a flat head screw driver. A power screwdriver or cordless drill is preferable. Ensure that the Phillips head fits neatly and fully engages the screw to avoid damage to the screws. Make sure that you tighten all screws securely and tap wooden dowels all the way in.

Warranty Information

We warranty our product for 10 years from date of shipment for manufacturer's defect and shipping damage within first 15 days. The warranty does not cover damage caused by abuse, mis-use, alteration, accident, or neglect of the product. The warranty does not cover damage caused by moving the cabinet fully loaded. Under the terms of this warranty, the repair and replacement of any parts shall be at the discretion of the company or their designated representative.

Replacement Parts Shipping Policy

To help protect our valuable resources, we ship all replacement parts at the same time. This procedure lessens the use of packaging materials and fossil fuels used in transportation keeping our world a cleaner place. Please help us in this endeavor by reviewing all parts in all boxes for damage before calling or emailing us to report damage. We adhere to this environmental philosophy by only shipping replacement parts 1 time for free. Future parts will be billed at customer's expense.

Cabinet Care

Your cabinet normally requires a minimum amount of maintenance, however, the following points are worth noting:

CLEANING- To remove marks and enhance the surface, wipe with general purpose cleaner.

CAUTION- Do not use ammonia based cleaning agents. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleansers. The surface can be wiped with a damp cloth but should be dried quickly.



Parts are labeled with capital letters. To reference letters, turn to the Wood Parts List in the back of your manual.







Cabinet Assembly


Step 1. Place Top (A), Bottom (B), Door (K) and Door Bin Front Panel (H) on a flat protected surface to


prevent scratching of parts, thread cam bolts (16 total) into pre-drilled holes (as shown In FIG. 1).



Step 2. Install Cams (8 total) by pushing a cam into each hole flush with surface, the arrow on the cams should be turned (using a regular screwdriver) to face the hole in each edge where the cam bolts will enter.


After installing the cams, insert the Dowels 8x30 (x8) in the both Side panels (C & D) as shown in FIG. 2.





Step 4. Turn Bottom (B) panel over and install the Locking caster on right front and Non-locking casters in the back and left front using the

preinstalled threaded seats and placing Caster washer between caster and cabinet bottom. Tighten with spanner.



Step 5. Install Lifter rails on Left (C) and Right (D)
Side Panel using pre-drilled holes with 6 Screws
M4x14mm. Top of rail is even with top of panel.




Step 6. In each of the two Door Bin Sides (I) panels, install 10 mm cams (x8) with arrow on cam pointing to hole on outer edge as shown in FIG. 6.

In Door Bin Bottom Panel (J) install Wood dowels (x6) in the holes on all sides.



Step 7. Attach Sides (I) to Bottom panel (J) by pushing dowels on short sides of J into holes on sides I (FIG. 7).

Attach Front Panel (H) to unit by inserting cam bolts into Sides (I) and seating dowel from Bottom




Step 8. Using 2 Screws (M4x14mm) for each door hinge attach hinges to raised section of Door (K). Attach Door catch plate with screw included in

hardware bag (#5 x 5/8 Brass Flathead Screw). Install the Locking caster through caster plate on bottom of Door (K).



Step 9. Place Bottom Panel (B) on level surface with cam bolts and dowels up. Place Left (C) and


Right (D) Side Panel on Bottom (B) with cam bolts in cam holes and dowels aligned. Tighten 4 cams.





Step 10. Set Back Panels (E) between panels C holes in side panels into back and tighten 2 screws and D. Insert the Screw 10x60mm (x4) through on each side. Press screw head covers in place.



Step 11. Attach the Lifter Board (F) to Lifter unit with Screws M4x14mm (x4).



Step 12. Install the lifter onto side rails following these steps.


A. Position lifter guides (white plastic) over rails and gently slide the lifter into position.

B. Loop Cable through Metal Tab on top of each lifter rail and secure. A flat screwdriver blade can


be used to push cord into tab. Push lifter down until it clicks into first position. When lifter has locking in first position, a small block of wood will disengage from the rear of the lifter where it was holding the cylinder, be sure to remove and discard it.









Step 13. Place Top (A) onto the cabinet and tighten 4 cams inside to secure the top.




Accessories to Complete Your Sewing Experience
